Materials and Tools (a short list)

- **1.** A 40 Watt electric soldering iron, with a section diameter of 6 mm. You can use the 60 Watt one, but you have to turn it off on time so as not to burn the fabric.
- 2. Scissors
- 3. A ballpoint pen
- 4. Curved tip tweezers
- **5.** Straight tip tweezers
- 6. An awl
- 7. A smooth spoon tool 5 6mm
- **8.** Japanese knife to make veins of the leaves.
- 9. An ultra-thin Japanese knife with a groove
- 10. Stamens
- **11.** 2 ironing sponges (hard and soft)
- **12.** Toothpick or bamboo stick
- 13. A strip of satin cut along the fiber direction (to color in green) 10 x 5 cm
- **14.** Adhesive paper tape or silk ribbon 0.5 (0.9) cm wide (no need to color)
- 15. Rectangular piece of glass or plastic with a smooth surface in A4 format
- **16.** PVA glue (soft one for transferring leaves and sepals on the lining / hard one for assembly of the flower)
- 17. Aniline dyes (powder or liquid)
- **18.** Small pliers to change the tools in the soldering iron
- 19. Metal wire: gauge 33, 28, 24
- 20. Paint brushes
- 21. A stapler
- **22.** The fabric of <u>only white color</u> (see the details in the technical table)
- 22. An old toothbrush
- 23. A rectangular piece of glass or smooth plastic (A4 size)
- **24.** A wet terry towel (very well wrung out)
